SHOTGUN REPORT

Thanks to the generous donations received, the new Five-Stand Sporting Clays facility is now completed and in full operation!

The course consists of ten traps (or throwers) positioned at various locations around field three. The targets consist of incomers, out-goers, crossers, rabbits, chondels, and just about any combination you can think of.

There are five shooting positions or stands. Each shooter fires at five different targets, then rotates to the next stand. A full round is 25 targets.

No special equipment is needed. A regular hunting shotgun that is capable of holding two shells is perfect. A 12 or 20 gauge works very well with some shooters using 28 gauge and even a .410. Most shooters have not shot this game before so complete instruction will be available to those that are new. 12 gauge ammo is available at the range.

The Spring Trap League starts Wednesday March 14th running through May 30th. Get a team together and come shoot or we can get you onto a team very easily.

The clays, trap, & skeet ranges are open to members and the public on Wednesdays from 3:00PM to 5:30PM and Saturdays 10:00AM until 2:00PM. All of these times are subject to weather conditions. As the days get longer and summer approaches these hours will be expanded. **Cost is \$6.00 per round of 25 for members and \$7.00 for non-members.**

Our new 5 Stand Clays Range, as well as the entire shotgun facility, is also available for special events, company parties, team building events and church outings. For more information please call Bill Thompson at 480-259-8825
